You must ask your class teacher for permission to leave their lesson to attend your music lesson – please ensure you do this at the start of your school lesson so that your class teacher can plan the lesson time accordingly.

Please note that music lessons will **continue as usual** throughout school 'early closures' and progress and target setting days – students are expected to remain at school, or return at the appropriate time for their lesson. If in doubt about whether you have a lesson or not, ask Ms Stephens in the Music Office.

It is your responsibility to arrive at your lesson at the correct time – copies of this timetable are displayed in the Music Department and on the school website. Occasionally, it may be necessary for your instrumental music teacher to alter the time of your lesson – any changes will be clearly written into your yellow practise book and displayed on the Music Department notice board so please check the noticeboard regularly.

A term's music lessons consists of 10 lessons – the 'catch-up' lesson will be used if your teacher has had to cancel a lesson earlier in the term. **If you miss a lesson, your teacher won't usually make up the lesson time as they were here, ready to teach you.**

Trips and Tests – sometimes, you may have a trip or a school test which means you can't attend your music lesson. We don't make up missed lessons, but we will always do our best to re-arrange your music lesson so that you don't miss it. If you know that you can't attend your lesson, come to see Ms Stephens in the Music Office **the day before** and we will do our best to switch your lesson time with someone else.

** Remember that music lessons will continue throughout the afternoon (during SPD)
