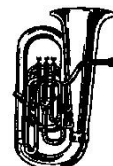

GENERAL INFORMATION

All forms should be returned to the **Music Department** at **Alexandra Park School**. Once we receive your completed application, we will send you details regarding payment, which will need to be made through Parent Pay by the stated deadline.

Please note that your contact details, as given on the reverse of this form, will be passed onto your instrumental teacher so that they can contact you directly regarding lesson times and your child's progress. If you do not wish your details to be passed on, please inform us in writing.

WHEN LESSONS START

Lessons usually start the second week of each school term (third week of the Autumn Term). Timetables are displayed on the Music Department notice board, on the school website and a hardcopy of the timetable will be given to your child's form tutor to pass on. However, the most up to date information will be on the Music Department Notice board and it is very important that students check this regularly.

Missed lessons

If the teacher is absent or the school is closed, lessons will be made up. If the pupil is absent, teachers will attempt to make up the lesson, but are not obliged to do so. If you are aware that your child will be absent (e.g. for an appointment, holiday or school trip) please give us **3 weeks written notice** to rearrange the lesson.

INSTRUMENTS

Pupils must have an instrument which they can use to practise at home. In many cases you will be able to hire an instrument from HMS. If this is not possible you will need to provide your own. If you wish to buy an instrument for use in these lessons you may be eligible for our **Assisted Instrument Purchase Scheme**. Please contact HMS on 020 8489 8960 for further details.

If you hire an instrument from MPAC you must make arrangements to collect it from them, insure it and return it to MPAC at the end of the hire period.

MOVING ON

Once your child is learning, it is important that you take an active interest, communicating with the teacher via the **Pupil Progress Book**, encouraging them to practise daily and, as they progress further, encouraging them to join one of our **school ensembles** and/or **Haringey Young Musicians** weekly ensembles to play with other young musicians of a similar standard.

CURRENT SCALE OF CHARGES (as at 01.05.16) (teachers normally give 10 lessons per term)

10 x 20 minute individual lessons £107.00

10 x 30 minute individual lessons £160.00

Payment may be made in two instalments.

A £80 reduction will apply on proof of income support. Further reductions apply for GCSE, BTEC & A level Music.

Once the application form has been received by the School office payment can be made via your child's ParentPay account.
